

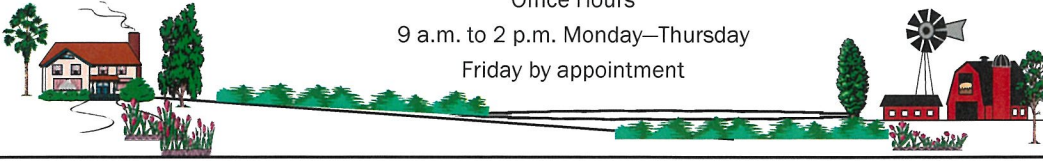

FARM MACHINERY AND ROAD SAFETY

It is Fall Harvest time! Farmers are on the move and will be sharing the road with you. Please show respect and consideration for the slower moving machinery. Please stay back 500 feet. Do not pass on the double line. Please be courteous.



UPCOMING SEASON REQUIRES SPECIAL CONSIDERATION

*Please remain a safe distance behind the snowplows. State law requires a distance of 200 feet, which may seem like more than enough, but as snowplow drivers clear away intersections, it is easy for them to use these feet quickly.

*There is **NO PARKING** on town roads, streets, or right of ways from December 1 through April 1. Vehicles will be ticketed and towed at **your** expense!

*If your mailbox has a weak post or attachment to the post, it can easily be pushed over by the weight of the snow, so it's **not** always fair to presume the snowplow drivers were responsible.

*Please **DO NOT** push your snow across the street from your driveway!!

TOWN HALL IS NOT A DUMPING GROUND

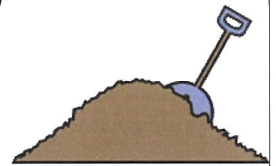
