TOWN BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
August 12,2019**

Call to Order: Chair Lyle Updike called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. at the Town Hall, 5556 Twin Lane Road. Supervisor D Yelk, Supervisor J Seltzner, Clerk R Wiedenbeck, Treasurer K Weisensel were present. Guests: Jared Blaska.

Statement of Public Notice: Record in the minutes that the notice of this meeting posted on three Town bulletin boards on August 8,2019.

Pledge of Allegiance: Supervisor D Yelk led the pledge.

Approve Minutes from Prior Meeting: Supervisor J Seltzner made a motion to approve minutes from the previous board meeting, seconded by Supervisor D Yelk.
Aye Votes: L Updike, J Seltzner, D Yelk. Nay Votes: None. Motion Carries.

Presentation of the Public: None.

Consider/take action: Campgrounds within the Town of Sun Prairie. Resident, Jared Blaska posted on Facebook an advertisement for camping available for Luke Bryan Concert goers on his property for a certain dollar amount. The board explained to Resident, Jared Blaska that his property is not zoned for him to be able to run a campground. They also explained he could have his family and friends stay there, but he could not charge them. There was no action taken at this time.

Consider/take action: Approve zoning change for Joseph A and Nancy J Coppola, in Section 17, Parcel# 811-171-8500-4 located at 5790 Parkview Rd, from Legacy (R-3) zoning to Town Zoning (MFR). No action taken, needs to attend the Planning Commission Meeting and the Public Hearing.

Consider/take action: Ordinance Amendment to section 1.022 Town Zoning Ordinance on: Storage of Boats, Recreational Vehicles and Other Property. Moved by Supervisor J Seltzner to approve, second by Supervisor D Yelk. Aye Votes: L Updike, J Seltzner, D Yelk. Nay Votes: None. Motion carries.

Consider/take action: Received written complaint of business being run out of a residential home located at 5178 HWY TT. Supervisor D Yelk made a motion to refer this to General Engineering Company (GEC) for further investigation. Seconded by Supervisor J Seltzner. Aye Votes: L Updike, J Seltzner, D Yelk. Nay Votes: None. Motion carries.

Consider/take action: Received written complaint from an anonymous resident regarding fireworks being shot off at 3156 Nelson Rd, without a permit. Moved by Supervisor D Yelk to send a letter to individual with a copy of the ordinance, which requires a permit for fireworks. Second by Supervisor J Seltzner. Aye Votes: L Updike, J Seltzner, D Yelk. Nay Votes: None. Motion carries.
